We are in the process of organising the clubs for the Autumn term and letters will be sent home during the first week of term. NB: Miss Gledhill had to reschedule the Fun with Phonics session this week due to attending a school meeting, therefore, her last session for this group will be next Wednesday.

## **SPORTS COACHING 2017/18**

As you will be aware, from September Miss Lockwood is our new Sports Coach. As such there will be a number of changes taking place:

- All children need full and proper PE kit please (navy shorts, white t-shirt, navy tracksuit and trainers for outdoor PE). Children will not be allowed to wear any other clothing for PE
- From September we will be running the Daily Mile each day. Children will be given the opportunity to do this at 12.45pm every day organised by Miss Lockwood. It is actually 15 laps of our playground! Children will be encouraged to take part but for any who really do not want to participate, there will be another play space provided. Due to this, we would ask for parents to consider footwear carefully for September. Black trainers are suitable as are any sturdier full shoes that support the children's feet well. This is particularly relevant to the girls as we cannot allow them to run in sandals, heels or flimsy shoes so please bear this in mind if you would like to encourage your child to take part in the Daily Mile
- We will be moving swimming into Y4 for all children so there will be no swimming for anyone next year (as Y3 children have already been this year). Next year's Y3 children will undertake swimming when they are in Y4

## **SPORTS WEEK**

In the week commencing 10<sup>th</sup> July, the children will be participating in our annual Sports Week. All children will have a chance to compete against others over the week, both in school and (for some) against children from other schools. Our official Sports Day will be undertaken on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> July (weather permitting!). In the morning we will be undertaking team events on the field. This is where all the children complete a series of activities and earn points for their team. This is a very active morning for the children and is a great time to come to see them really participate and compete. It starts at 9.15am. In the afternoon each class has a slot to do traditional races and parents are welcome to come and watch these too.
